

## **SUNBELT CLASSIC FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS!**

**Why was I moved to Gold when we requested Silver?** Since the CSYSA Spring Assignments will be completed when we schedule, we are following those assignments. Premier level teams are in Gold, Classic Teams are in Silver and Challenge Teams are in Bronze. If you requested Silver, but you will be playing in Premier – you were moved to Gold. We are allowing teams to play up upon their request, but not down.

**Medical Release Forms** – are required for ALL players, but do not need to be notarized. Forms are available on our website <http://www.pueblorangers.net/Sunbelt2010/index.htm> and the CYS website: [www.csysa.org](http://www.csysa.org)

**Acceptance Packet** – will be e-mailed shortly after the Registration Deadline. It includes the intro letter, tournament rules, the Sunbelt Roster and the Guest Roster.

**Where is Registration:** We will announce the location as soon as it's available.

**Check-In / Registration** – Is required for ALL teams. You must have the following for all players: laminated player card and medical release form. For each team you must have 2 copies of the Sunbelt Roster, 2 copies of the Guest Roster and 1 copy of your State Roster. Out of State Teams are required to have permission to travel papers also (See the tournament Rules for paper work needed for out of state teams.)

**How many guest players?** 4 per team (3 for U10). Players may not play down in age or bracket. In other words – a Bronze team may not have Premier level players as guest players. High school girls teams are exempt from the guest player limitations.

**Concessions** – We will have booster club concessions at all sites with food & drink. We will also have T-Shirts for sale at all Sites. Coaches packet will have coupons for the players to receive their free tournament pin – and \$1 off a t-shirt in the Concessions/T-Shirt tent.

**Red Cards/Yellow Cards/Sit Outs** etc. We are a CYS registered Tournament – all sit outs will be enforced. All yellow/red cards will be reported to CYS.

**Referee Tents** – Are OFF limits to everyone. We adhere strictly to a zero level tolerance for referee abuse. We cannot have a tournament without the referees – so we value their services.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded to players on the 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams. Trophies will be given to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams. The championship game will consist of the two teams with the highest point total in the bracket. When a bracket is too large – we will split the bracket into 2, creating an “A” and “B” bracket. These will function separately and awards will be given to the top teams in each bracket. With limited playing time we do not have the time to have semi-finals and finals. Third place is awarded solely on points. Medals and Trophies will not be shipped. Awards are given out by the Site Directors at each site.

**At the Site:** We run each site like a individual tournament. Each site will have a set of Site directors who can be located at the administration trailer, T-shirt Sales and Concessions in the warming tent, A referee tent which is off-limits to players and coaches, and field marshals identified in bright orange vests.
